Carrier Filings Report

The ICRB is pleased to announce a new information service. We are now posting a rate guide report on our website. The report tracks carrier filings of rates, loss cost multipliers (LCMs), and class specific deviations that carriers submit to the Indiana Department of Insurance (DOI).

The list tracks the top 100 carriers (not groups) by premium size as reported to the NAIC. It contains all filings received for the year as of the date of the report and will be updated monthly.

Providing this information supports two of the powers of the Bureau as specified in its By-Laws:

- to collect, compile and distribute past and current prices of individual companies if such information is made available to the general public;
- pursuant to guidelines adopted by the Governing Board for the purpose of encouraging competitive activity, to assist individual companies to develop minimum premiums, rates, supplementary rate information or supporting information when so authorized by the individual company;

Beginning in 2006, the Indiana Department of Insurance arranged with the firm Perr & Knight that all policy forms, rates and rules filed with the DOI are being scanned and made available to the public online. The ICRB has an agreement with Perr & Knight to post Indiana workers compensation filings on our website.
